The Government of Saint Lucia, through the Caribbean Digital Transformation Project in conjunction with the Division of Public Sector Modernization within the Department of Public Service, is currently conducting Stakeholder Consultations to guide the development of a National Broadband Policy, Strategy, and Implementation Plan for St. Lucia, of which the primary goals include:

- Promoting widespread and equitable access to high-speed broadband services across Saint Lucia.
- Ensuring reliable broadband service availability to all users.
- Making broadband services affordable for everyone within the next five years.

This initiative is a cornerstone of the Government of Saint Lucia's broader national objective to build a knowledge-based economy. By developing the telecommunications services sector, the government seeks to:

- Position telecommunications as a significant driver for economic growth.
- Facilitate job creation within the telecommunications and related sectors.
- Leverage improved connectivity to alleviate poverty by enhancing access to information, services, and opportunities.

The successful development and implementation of the National Broadband Policy, Strategy, and Action Plan will:

- Establish a regulatory and infrastructural framework that supports the growth of broadband services.
- Encourage innovation and the use of digital technologies in various sectors.
- : Enhance the quality of life for citizens by providing better access to education, healthcare, and government services through reliable internet connectivity.

Key stakeholders include Government departments and agencies, Regulators, Telecommunications companies, ISPs, and businesses relying on digital infrastructure, Non-governmental organizations, community groups, and the general public.
